Using Behavioral Skills Training "BST" Within the home setting


 Behavioral Skills Training is an <u>effective</u> and <u>empirically validated</u> multi-component teaching method to train or teach new skills to individuals *regardless* of disability.

Instructions	Modeling	Rehearsal	Feedback
Checklist or Task Analysis	Demonstration of the steps		Discuss and practice to mastery
