Citizens Budget Oversight Committee

The Citizens Budget Oversight Committee met on March 20 to review the District financial reports for February 2019. In attendance were CFO Bob Silber; board liaison Elizabeth Paige; and CBOC members Bud Mullin, Kristin Liggen, David Stockman and Laura Nash.

The Financial Reports reviewed for February were prepared by the District utilizing information from the State Accounting System. The balances from these internally generated reports align with reports generated by the State Accounting System. The reports provided by the District include a record of current expenditures and revenues. The documentation includes encumbrances, expenditures, and remaining funds available, as required by Delaware Administrative Code. In addition, the reports provides operating expenses identified by source of funds: State; Local Restricted; Local Unrestricted; Capital; and Federal.

For Agency 3300 receipts for the month were \sim \$1.5 Million. State revenue for the period was \sim \$160 thousand. Local revenue for this period was \sim \$1.3 Million.

Non-Federal operating expenses year to date are ~ \$ 150.7 Million, representing 57.14% of the approved budget, with 66.67% of the year completed. No unusual activity to report.

Decrease in receipts for Delaware Autism Program are a result of transportation funding changes made by the state.
