

### Vaccination Testing Mandate - Nov. 1

- Oct 18, Governor Carney and Department of Health and Social Services issued an emergency regulation requiring educators, school staff, volunteers and contractors working in Delaware schools to be vaccinated against COVID-19 or undergo weekly testing beginning November 1.
- Data Service Center has developed the COVID-19 Vaccine and Testing application to support the district implementation to go live on November 1.
- All district employees will be required to submit proof of vaccination status or proof of weekly testing.

### **Employee Relations**

- We continue to communicate and work with all of our employee groups.
- The district team has weekly meetings with our Teacher and Paraprofessional leadership teams.
- Monthly liaison meetings with Transportation, Secretaries, Child Nutrition, Custodians and Maintenance.

Students ages 5-11 are now eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine.





### Weekly COVID-19 Testing

- Christina School District encourages our families to enroll their students, regardless of vaccination status, in our weekly rapid COVID-19 (antigen) testing program.
- All families must register their student(s), even those who participated last year. Students, with an approved consent, will be tested weekly while at school. Testing will be completed in a matter of minutes using a nasal swab.

### Christina School Choice Updates

#### November 1, 2021 - January 12, 2022

- Students may:
  - Attend the school they are assigned to next year. No further action is required. This
    includes Christina School District Virtual Academy. OR
  - Utilize the Choice process to apply to attend another Christina school.
- Students who are currently in the Christina School District Virtual Academy (CSDVA) in grades 5 and 8 will need to submit a new Choice application if they wish to continue in the Christina School District Virtual Academy (CSDVA) for the next grade configuration.
- Online OR paper applications
- If a student wants to attend a school other than the one they are assigned to next year,
   then they must submit a Choice application.
