

The Kitchen School

In partnership with the
Food Bank of Delaware,
this program offers specialized
training to provide employment
opportunities in the food and
hospitality industries for adults with
disabilities. Students spend 8 weeks
at the Food Bank kitchen
in Newark or Milford;
after that, an additional four weeks is
spent transitioning to permanent
employment through
on-site job coaching.





Hospitality Opportunities for People reEntering Society (HOPES)

Individuals will receive occupational skills training, 1 national recognized industry credential, and be paired with a local case manager and connected to 1 full year of industry employment at one of 45 restaurant locations throughout the state.

With funding from the Kessler Foundation, coordinated by state restaurant associations and community-based organization partners, the NRAEF will strengthen its resources, materials, Restaurant Ready delivery, and career pathway and apprenticeship opportunities to increase access options for people with disabilities.
