ELIGIBILITY: Contest is open to students in grades K-12. Entries should be scanned and those not meeting the formatting requirements will be disqualified. NO GROUP SUBMISSIONS. Please submit your original work with the attached entry form.

JUDGING CRITERIA: Entries will be judged in each of the eligible grade divisions (K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12). Relevance to the theme will be the prime factor for judging. All entries must be sent in any of the following formats: .jpg .png or PDF. IF your entry is hand drawn, send a photo of the drawing and we will request a scan of the document if the design is chosen.

WINNING ANNOUNCEMENT: Certificates will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each grade category. The overall FIRST PLACE awardee will be announced on #SELDay, Friday, March 26, 2021 and their work will be featured during Trauma Awareness Month in May 2021.
