

Principal's Message

Gauger-Cobbs Middle School Updates

Dear Gauger-Cobbs Families,

I hope this message finds you well as we begin May and approach the end of the school year. With just **26 school days remaining**, we have important updates to share.

Smarter Balanced State Testing – Next Week

Students will take the **Delaware State Smarter Balanced Assessments** in **ELA** and **Math**. These assessments serve as our school's academic performance report.

What We Need from Families:

- Encourage your student to give their best effort.
- Make sure your child gets plenty of sleep the night before each test.
- Ensure their Chromebook is fully charged each day.
- If possible, send your child with headphones for testing.(no wireless or blue tooth headphones)

Testing Rules & Reminders:

- Cell phones must be off and out of sight during testing.
 - Any use of a phone will be a **major testing violation** and reported to the Delaware DOE.
- After testing, students may:
 - Read a book.
 - Work on non-digital activities.
 - They may NOT use computers or phones until testing is officially over.

Testing Schedule:

- Monday ELA CAT (Computerized Adaptive Test)
- Tuesday ELA PT (Performance Task Writing)
- Wednesday Math CAT
- Thursday Math PT (Performance Task)

Makeup Testing:

- Students who are absent will be scheduled for makeup sessions.
- Our goal is to meet a 95% participation rate as required.

* Summer School Program

Students who are required to attend summer school have been notified via letter.

- Platform: Edgenuity (online learning)
- Delivery: Remote via Zoom
- Chromebooks: Issued for summer use
 - Students are responsible for any damage or loss

Nurse Contact Information

If your child has any of the symptoms below, please keep them home and send in an illness note upon their return to school.

- Sore throat
- Cough
- Shortness of breath, trouble breathing, severe wheezing
- · Chills or shaking with chills
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- · New loss of smell or taste
- Congestion, runny nose
- Fever of 100.4F or above

If your child is experiencing **ANY** of the symptoms above, have them tested (home tests acceptable) for COVID before returning to in person learning to assure the health and safety of the school community. *Please be mindful that a fever is not a common early symptom for COVID and is not the sole indicator of COVID-19.*
