A Message from the Principal

Good Evening Gauger Families,

We have a bit of a choppy week this week so I wanted to be sure that everyone remembers the schedule. Monday we are off for a Grading/PD day. Tuesday and Wednesday we are in school all day. Thursday and Friday of this week, students are out of school. Keep in mind that on Thursday it is Veteran's Day so there is no school.

Friday, November 12th (GOLD DAY) is a Remote learning day where students will follow our normal schedule and log in to their Schoology page for a Zoom link. The students are expected to be remote learning for the entire day and we will begin our schedule with BLOCK 1 at 8:00 a.m. We will NOT have an Advisory block on this school day!

If your child needs a hot spot for a connection at home, please have them see an administrator or technology coordinator so that we can make sure we get it to you before your child leaves on Wednesday.

Please note that this week is Veteran's Day and I wanted to to a minute to thank those men and women who are serving and have served our great nation! I hope everyone got a little more sleep today as we embark on the colder and darker days as a result of the clocks turning back this weekend. The first marking period has ended as of November 5th. Please keep in mind that the report cards will be loaded onto HAC by November 17th by 4:30 p.m. We are recommending that guardians/students frequently check Schoology and Home Access center to make sure that they are doing well in school. We thank you for your support of our students and staff.

As we conclude the 1st Marking Period, we have asked teachers to reach out to families for students who are failing in our Core Subject Areas.

Parent conferences will be coming up on 11/22 and 11/23 and the students will be off on these days. If you don't hear from a teacher where your student is failing, please email them to see if a conference can be scheduled. Parent conferences can be done virtually or in person. Please let the teacher know your preference of meeting in person or virtually for meeting on these dates. DISTRICT SECONDARY STUDENT MANUAL-REPEAT

Parents we ask you for your continued support with some of the followings expectations for all of our students! We had expectations assemblies this past week for all grade levels and reviewed many of the topics from our Student Manual. We stressed proper bus behavior, being on time to class, resolving conflicts, and getting additional supports if needed. I encourage you and your child to review our Student manual at this link: CLICK HERE

- Wearing Masks. Please be sure to have a conversation with your child about wearing a mask in school and on the bus. The mask should be pulled up over the nose and if students need a new one, we have plenty of masks for all. Thank you for helping us with the CDC and governor's order.
- Not carrying book bags during the school day. Students have ALL been issued a locker so they can drop off items during transition or get their lunch prior to the lunch block. Violators have been

given warnings on Friday and we will begin issuing consequences for students not following our expectations.

- **Uniforms.** Grade level shirts are the expectation and all students should be in their grade level colors at this time. Hoodies should also be the same color as the student polo.
- Red-6th, Gray-7th, and Navy Blue-8th. Additionally, we ask that you remind your student that they can NOT have a hoodie up in the school because of safety and security. We understand that some students are cold at times but they can't have the hood up in the building at any time.
- Phone usage in school. Parents, we have allowed students to use their phones in the cafeteria (Green Zone) during lunch as a reward. However, at all other times during the school day, the phone should not be used and we call this the (Red Zone). If a student is recording other students or teachers, taking calls/Facetiming during class, or doing other inappropriate things with the phone we will be dealing with those students by calling you and issuing disciplinary consequences. Please remember that students are NOT permitted to take calls during class or face time in school with anyone. Thank you for your support with this request.
- **Technology.** Please be sure to make sure your child takes care of their school-issued Chromebook. We are seeing an uptick in students damaging devices so it is important that they don't take them to lunch or play around with the devices. All students who have turned in a consent form have been given a device.
- **Fully Charged Chromebooks.** It is imperative that students come to school with a fully charged device every day that they are present. Chromebooks are used throughout the school day as an instructional tool.
- **Earbuds.** It is also very important for students to bring earbuds to school with them every day that they are present.

If your child is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or you have answered yes to **Any** of the COVID-19 screening questions, **do not send your child to school.** Your child will not be able to return to school until a clearance letter has been sent to your school nurse (kathleen.luna@christina.k12.de.us) by your child's primary care doctor, Delaware Public Health, or a negative COVID test result is submitted to the nurse.
