## A Message from the Principal

Good Evening Families,

I hope this message finds you doing well and you are having a nice weekend! I appreciate the flexibility of our families over the past two weeks as we continue to face challenges with staffing and COVID 19. We will continue to work together as this pandemic continues to challenge us with all that we do each day! Please know that we are all in this together!

Requests for support from families:

- Please be sure your student wears a mask at all times in school and on the bus because it is now a mandate by the Governor. Students need to keep the mask over the nose in the building.
- We announce each day that if a student needs a mask to please ask a teacher, bus driver, or the main office.
- Please be sure your child charges his/her Chromebook each night and is prepared to PIVOT at any time to remote learning.
- Please have a conversation with your child about being on time to class each period. The hall passing time is 5 minutes and no child should be late to class at any time. We do frequent sweeps of the hallways and chronic offenders will receive a call home and detention. Chronic offenders, more than two sweeps in a day will be referred for defiance and suspended out of school.
- Please remind your student that they are expected to be "In uniform" each day as expected by the school district. Students who are NOT compliant will not be able to attend PBS events and end-of-year celebrations like Move-up, Dinner dance, etc.

## Message from our School Nurse

I hope that everyone is staying healthy and safe during this time. Due to the overwhelming volume of COVID-19 cases we are currently experiencing, please allow 24-36 hours on the next business day for return correspondence.

Please keep your child home if they are feeling sick or have **ANY** of the following symptoms:

- Sore throat
- Cough
- Shortness of breath, trouble breathing, severe wheezing
- Chills or shaking with chills
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- New loss of smell or taste
- Congestion, runny nose
- Fever of 100.4F or above

If your child is experiencing **ANY** of the symptoms above, have them tested (home tests acceptable) for COVID before returning to in person learning to assure the health and safety of the school community. *Please be mindful that a fever is not a common early symptom for COVID and is not the sole indicator of COVID 19.*
