Principal's Message

Greetings Virtual Kirk Families and Friends,

I would like to welcome everyone to the Christina School District Middle School Virtual Academy (CSDVA). Since we have so many new families to Kirk I wanted to reach out separately to our virtual families today and provide specific updates for the CSDVA.



One of our goals in designing the Middle School CSDVA at Kirk is to create a program that mirrors the in-person experience. Our CSDVA students will follow the same schedule as our in-person students. This includes following the school schedule starting at 7:05 with classes to 2:05 daily. Our schedule and daily rotation are included in this newsletter.

One of the differences between this program and last year's hybrid is that our CSDVA classes will only contain Virtual Students. This will allow for more interaction between students and teachers online. Our expectation is that the virtual class will mimic an in-person class. In order to do that we are setting the following expectations.

- 1. Students are to attend class live just as if they were in person.
- 2. Students' cameras are to be on during class.
- 3. Students need to be sitting upright in a proper workplace such as a desk or at the kitchen table.
- 4. Students should be dressed appropriately for school/wearing a uniform is not required.

We believe that these expectations will help create the best mindset for students to learn and participate fully in their classes. On August 30th at 4:00 pm, we will hold a parent information meeting through zoom to go over this information. The link to the meeting is included in the section below the map.

Important Dates:

- Student Schedules will be available on HAC starting August 31st
- <u>Chromebooks (CSDVA students)</u>. If your child turned in their device last year they will be able to pick up their device at Kirk on August 31st between 2:00 5:00 pm. If your child still has their device they will not be issued a new device, however, if the device is not working properly we will trade it out at this time. The map below shows where families will drive through to pick up devices and their school supply kit.

Please note: The CSD Technology Agreement will need to be signed by a parent and student to receive their device. Copies will be available on the 31st.

- September 9th: All Middle School students attend classes. (7 & 8th-grade first day of school)



Antigen Testing Information & Consent Form

The Christina School District in partnership with the Delaware Department of Education, Delaware Public Health, and the Quidel Corporation, are offering the implementation of a rapid COVID-19 Testing Program. Like last year, registered students and staff will participate in weekly testing to detect the presence of COVID-19. These tests, similar to a rapid strep test, provide results in fifteen minutes. The Christina School District began offering this service in January of 2021. We are excited to continue offering this mitigation strategy for the 2021-22 school year. The Christina School District will use the following process to administer testing:

- Students/Families must opt in to the testing program by completing the consent for COVID-19 testing form. A copy is provided with this letter.
- Students, with an approved consent, will be tested weekly while at school. Testing will be provided and administered by the Quidel Corporation.

Testing will be completed in a matter of minutes using a nasal swab. The student and family will be notified of a positive result and required next steps. Quidel will also post all test results to a secure online portal for individual/parent review. To participate in the COVID-19 Antigen testing, we ask that you complete the consent for COVID-19 testing form accompanied to this letter. Please contact your child's school nurse if you have any questions regarding Antigen Testing.
