- Friday, June 10th there is no school for a grading day.
- The last school day is Monday, June 13th and dismissal that day is at 9:30 am.

This year all Chromebooks and chargers will be collected. This is being done to inventory equipment over the summer and prepare for the upcoming school year. 8th-grade students will be issued new devices in HS. 
8th Grade End of the Year Dates

- " All (virtual/in-person) students who have not yet turned in their computer with charger, will be collected at the ceremony.




Yearbooks are now on sale for \$20.00. The order form is attached below this section. Please turn in yearbook orders to Ms. Page in the Health room.


Promotion Requirements

Report Cards are now available on Home Access Center (HAC). https://www.christinak12.org/Domain/1964

State Requirement for Promotion:

Students in grades 1 to 8 must pass 50% of their instructional program each year (excluding physical education) to be promoted to the next grade level. One of the subject areas that must be passed is English Language Arts or its equivalent

This week we will be mailing letters to families with students that are in danger of not successfully meeting the state requirements for promotion. Those letters will explain what class(es) a student will need to pass and what grade they will need in the 4th Marking Period to a pass.

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Dress Code Update

I would like to thank our families that are supporting us with CSD Middle School Dress Code. Students that come to school completely out of dress code, wearing jeans (ripped or obviously not in dress code such as light blue jeans) will be asked to change into something from our clothes closet or call home for the proper clothing.

Reminders: leggings/tights/jeggings/sweatpants/jeans are not permitted to be worn as pants according to the dress code.

Hoodie Policy: While the dress code policy states no hoodies we will be flexible and allow students to wear a grade level color hoodie as the temperature is getting colder. This accommodation will be allowed as long as students keep their hoods down while in the building. All coats and jackets should be placed in their lockers as students arrive in the building.
