

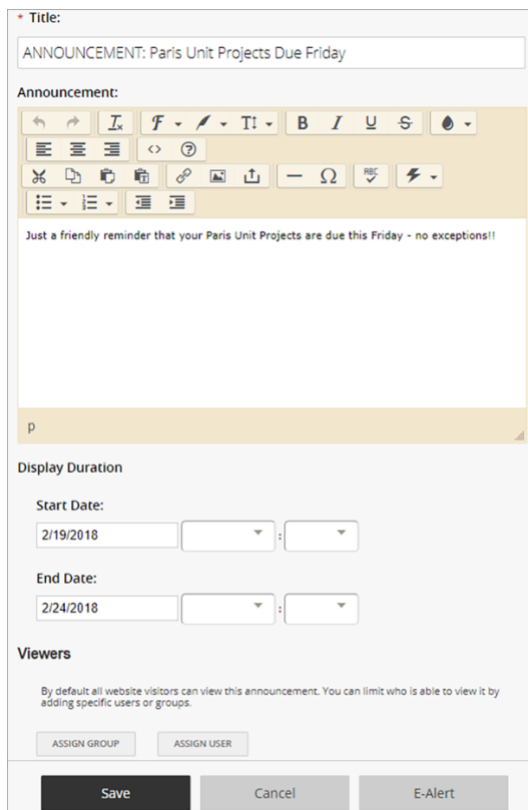
Announcements App User Guide

1. Enter the *Title* and the *Announcement* text.
2. Select the values for *Display Duration* if you wish to include these variables.
3. Select the *Viewers* to change the default setting for all visitors.
4. Select *Save*.

Set display duration

For many apps, you can set start and end dates and times for app records. Here's how display dates and times display for app records.

- If no start and end date times are specified, the record displays on the website upon saving and never expires.
- If you enter start and end dates and times, the record displays on your site within the specified date and time ranges.
- If you enter only a start date and time, the record displays on your site from the date and time specified.
- If you enter only an end date and time, the record displays on your site until the specified end date and time.
- To remove the *Display Duration* for an app, remove the start and end date.
- The start time defaults to 12:00 A.M.
- The end time defaults to 11:59 P.M.
