As part of our preparation, we have devised a Pandemic Preparedness Action Plan. We will move through the phases of this plan as advised by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and <u>Delaware Division of Public Health.</u>

CSD will monitor COVID-19 status daily to determine appropriate phase.

Follow CDC and Delaware Division of Public Health guidelines.			

Do not attend school if you are sick. Any student or staff who is determined to be sick while at school will be sent home.

- Mandatory 14-day quarantine for any staff member or student with a confirmed case or living with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.
- Mandatory 14-day quarantine for all staff that traveled to/from or who have someone living with them who has traveled to/from designated CDC level 3 areas.
- Mandatory 14-day quarantine for all students that have traveled to/from CDC designated level 3 areas.
