Insects: The Very Hungry Caterpillar

<u>ELA</u> Point out and write letter C with your child	<u>ELA</u> Read a book about bugs	<u>ELA</u> Watch this short video with your child! The Very Hungry Caterpillar	<u>ELA</u> Point out different body parts and try to name some that belong to bugs!
<u>Math</u> Count food items on your plate during a mealtime.	<u>Math</u> Make a square, triangle, and rectangle using household items such as pretzels, popsicle sticks, or crayons	<u>Math</u> Make a "caterpillar" pattern! Use items like Legos, blocks, or cut up straws and line them up!	<u>Math</u> Roll a dice and jump that many times like a grasshopper
<u>Social-Emotional</u> Greet family members in a fun new way! Wave like a butterfly, or hop like a grasshopper.	<u>Social-Emotional</u> Wrap your child up in a blanket like a caterpillar in a chrysalis. Help them wiggle free and fly away!	<u>Sensory</u> Dump salt, flour, or shaving cream onto a cookie tray and practice writing letter C	<u>Sensory</u> Wash your fruits and vegetables (plastic ones are great too!)
<u>Art</u> Create your favorite bug using anything you can find at home!	<u>Science</u> Go for a walk and look for bugs with your child.	<u>Science</u> Create insect using snacks! Here are some fun items you may have around to use: Pretzel sticks, raisins, grapes, crackers, cream cheese, etc.	<u>Physical Activity</u> Bug movement: crawl like a caterpillar, fly like a butterfly, slither like a worm
