**Pets, Animals, etc.**

<b><u>ELA</u></b> Use materials around the house to make the letter C for Cat or D for Dog.	<b><u>ELA</u></b> Read a book about pets	<b><u>ELA</u></b> Talk about different animals and the sounds they make.	<b><u>ELA</u></b> Act like different animals and see if your child can guess which animal you are.
<b><u>Math</u></b> Write numerals with chalk and have your child exercise that many times on each numeral (ex. Jump 5 times on the numeral 5)	<b><u>Math</u></b> Go on an animal hunt outside! Count how many animals you can find.	<b><u>Math</u></b> Gather some of your small toys and sort them by color.	<b><u>Math</u></b> Shape hunt Show your child a shape and let them try to find that shape in an object around your house or outside.
<b><u>Social-Emotional</u></b> Have a teddy bear picnic with all of your stuffed animals!	<b><u>Social-Emotional</u></b> Do wish you well with your favorite stuffed animals or your real pets at home.	<b><u>Social-Emotional</u></b> Greet your family members using an animal sound.	<b><u>Art</u></b> Find a rock outside and paint or color it to create your own pet rock.
<b><u>Art</u></b> Use materials you have at home to create an animal or pet. Examples: Cotton balls, Toilet paper rolls, construction paper, shoebox.	<b><u>Science</u></b> Go on a nature walk and see what animal tracks you can find.	<b><u>Jobs</u></b> Give your toy animals a bath.	<b><u>Physical Activity</u></b> Animal Actions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Move like an elephant</li> <li>• Jump like a kangaroo</li> <li>• Buzz like a bee</li> <li>• Gallop like a horse</li> <li>• Slither like a snake</li> </ul>
