Week 1: Nature All Around Us: What's in the sky?/Weather

<u>ELA</u> Go for a walk, look at the clouds, talk about the shapes that you see	<u>ELA</u> Draw a picture of you during day/night and have an adult write your words	<u>ELA</u> write your name in rainbow colors	<u>ELA</u> Use shaving cream, sugar/salt, flour on a tray/plate and write letters, words, names
<u>Math</u> Counting cotton balls/paper towels then make a cloud	<u>Math</u> Counting stars at night, record on paper, connect the dots to make constellations	<u>Math</u> Make a weather graph	<u>Math</u> Sort hot/cold items (what items are hot/cold, what can you wear when it's hot/cold?)
<u>Social-Emotional</u> Pick a color from the rainbow and think about how that color makes you feel. (yellow—happy, blue—calm, etc.)	<u>Social-Emotional</u> Make a fort and snuggle up with a book. Invite a family member to snuggle and talk about your favorite parts of the book.	<u>Social-Emotional</u> How does the weather make you feel? Talk about how different types of weather makes you feel?	<u>Social-Emotional</u> What's your favorite thing to do in all types of weather? (example: take naps when it's rainy, build a snowman when it's snowy, etc.)
<u>Social Studies</u> Watch the weather channel and look at the different kinds of weather in other parts of the country/world	<u>Science</u> Use a flashlight (can be from a phone) and make shadows or shadow puppets	<u>Jobs</u> Meteorologist: Look outside and tell what the weather is each day	<u>Physical Activity</u> Nature Walk: Use the scavenger hunt guide
