

## Zoom Meeting Expectations



- You and your family have designated a quiet workplace for you to attend to your learning. You may wear headphones to help block noise.

- Be on time! Your parents are to notify the teacher when you will not be attending or leaving the session early.
- You must be dressed appropriately for the zoom meetings. Unless it is a pajama day, dress as if you were coming into the school.
- Eat your breakfast before joining the zoom.
- Be sure to sit up at a table or desk. Lying in bed or on a couch is not acceptable.
- All supplies need to be in the work area for learning.
- You are expected to turn in assignments in a timely manner.
- You are to communicate with your teacher if you are having trouble so that your teacher is better able to support your learning.

**DRESS**



- During zoom, be an active participant.

Be sure the computer is charged for instruction.

Properly identification is required on the zoom.

Keep virtual backgrounds appropriate and distraction free.

Cameras **MUST** remain on during the instruction.

Toys, electronics, stuffed animals are to be put away before instruction begins.

Create a routine at home and being consistent will help your child be successful. Have a set bedtime and wake up at the same time each day.
