During the 2018-2019 school year, Christina School District shifted to a standards-based grading approach in kindergarten through grade 5. The K-5 report card will provide a more accurate view of a student's progress in academic and behavioral areas. Factors like responsibility, participation, effort and attendance are reported separately, and not as an indicator of a student's academic performance.
