1ST GRADE

First graders welcomed in the New Year by making New Year's Resolutions! In Reading, we read an information story, Seasons. We focused on the comprehension strategy of cause & effect. Our phonics focus: sh, wh & ph diagraph. In writing we are learning to stay on topic, and include details with complete sentences. We will be working on writing to inform through our pieces. 2ND GRADE

Happy New Year second grade families! Last week we spent a lot of time looking at pictures of artifacts from the late 1700's. This was part of our unit about life long ago. Students enjoyed looking at each picture and trying to figure out what each object was used for in the past. 3RD GRADE

Third graders were busy this week! We continued learning about text features used in nonfiction texts. Students started researching and taking notes on the history of candy using internet sources. 4TH GRADE

Fourth grade has been working hard. In Math, we are writing equivalent fractions, decimals and getting ready for our end of unit assessment. In Science we are investigating magnetism and will begin exploring circuits using a battery, wire and lightbulb. Hopefully, things will really light up soon! RELATED ARTS: PHYS ED, MUSIC, LIBRARY & ART

Physical Education We are continuing our Safer, Smarter Kids Health units with each grade level: Kindergarten is learning about their Safety Stop Sign, using their I Mean Business Voice when they see something that is not safe, who their Grownup Buddies are, and determining who is in their Trusted Triangle.

1st Grade is reviewing their Safety Stop Sign, who their Grownup Buddies are, and who is in their Trusted Triangle, as well as using their Guiding Voice when faced with a Think-Feel-Act situation.

2nd Grade is learning about their Safety Superstar Tools, which includes their Safety Stop Sign, I Mean Business Voice, Trusted Triangle, Safety Barometer, and T-F-A. They are also learning about using their Safety Goggles to assess safe and unsafe situations.

3rd Grade is learning about being a Good Citizen, their Safety NETwork, Digital Safety, and Social Media.

4th Grade is learning about the Kids' Bill of Rights, having a Voice, and The Right to Be Heard. 5th Grade is learning about Peer Pressure, Courage, Cyber Bullying, Harassment, and having a Cyber P.L.A.N.

<u>Library</u>

In library, we are continuing our work on genres of literature with a focus on fantasy and poetry. Younger students have enjoyed the Doreen Cronin books while older students have listened to a sampling of the chapter book, Three Good Deeds by Vivian Van Velde. A variety of poems have been used and students in second and third grades wrote winter haiku poems. Students are practicing using the Kami and Nearpod apps

for both synchronous and asynchronous library assignments.
