Brader’s Movie & Video Procedure

The following Movie & Video Procedure is in place this school year regarding the showing of movies, videos or technology clips:

- Classroom teachers or staff planning to show a movie, video or clip in the classroom will have received administration’s approval.
- Classroom teachers or staff will only show a movie, video or clip in the classroom for educational purposes, incentives or rewards. An advanced written notice will be sent home to parents/guardians for the purpose of an incentive or reward that is longer than 30 minutes in length and include the date and time of the planned showing.
- Movies less than 30 minutes in length may be shown during indoor recess and will be pre approved by the administration, but notices will not be sent home to parents. Grade level teams will not show movies during indoor recess that require a viewing time of more than 30 minutes, a continuation into instructional time or that may necessitate more than one recess period to view.

PG Movie Permission Slip

These movies, videos or clips may possibly have a rating of G or PG (parental guidance). District regulations require teachers to have parental permission to show any movies rated over G in class. By signing this permission slip you are allowing your child to watch a PG rated movie in school. If you have any questions please feel free to contact the classroom teacher or the school office.
