Academic, behavioral and attendance records will be reviewed prior to approval.

Students with excessive absences/tardies, behavioral infractions, and/or failing grades will *not* be granted a parking permit.

Once a student is determined to have met the requirements, spaces are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis until all spaces are assigned. Priority is given to seniors.

Seniors can turn in this application beginning **August 9th until August 20th**. After this date, parking spaces will open up to juniors.

I agree to and understand the following:

- An accumulation of unexcused tardies may result in a loss of driving privileges
- Be responsible for all persons in my vehicle and their actions
- Disciplinary action that results in a suspension will lose driving privileges
- Follow all vehicular laws
- Leaving school grounds without administrative permission is an automatic suspension and loss of driving privileges
- Speed limit must remain under 10 mph
- Student cars must be parked in the designated student parking areas (yellow spaces) in the West parking lot
- Students and passengers are NOT allowed on campus before 6:45 am without administrator permission
- Students must have written permission from the office to go to their car during school day
- Students must refer to and abide by conditions outlined in the Student Handbook. A parking pass may be revoked at any time
- The district presumes a student possesses and is therefore responsible for items in the student's motor vehicle.
- Any vehicle may be searched at any time
- Unauthorized parking and/or repeated parking violations may result in the vehicle being towed at the owner's expense, disciplinary action, and/or loss of driving privileges
- When buses begin to exit, student drivers must WAIT until all buses exit. Cutting into bus lines will result in the loss of driving privileges
- Written permission is required from a principal before parking in any other location NOT designated as the assigned student parking area
- Administration has final determination to revoke/deny driving privileges

I, the undersigned, understand and will abide by the all of the rules and expectations listed above as well as those implied. If I violate any of the above rules or drive in a reckless manner, I will lose my driving privileges. I understand that driving at Newark High School is a privilege. I understand that if my vehicle breaks down, it is not considered to be an excused tardy.
